

ILT GRANTS ALLOCATED ON 10 AUGUST 2017

Chamber of Commerce Southland

A total grant to a level of **\$3,000** to assist with the Business Excellence Awards to be held on 29 September 2017.

Environment Southland

A total grant to a level of **\$1,500** to assist with hosting of the South Island Civic Defence and Emergency Management Conference on 17th and 18th August 2017.

Queens Park Golf Club

A total grant to a level of **\$4,200** to assist with hosting the Golf in the Park annual tournament on 14th and 15th October 2017.
